- Course Verifications sent home via email in March - requested changes must be signed by parent

## OUTDOOR EDUCATION 11/12

- NEW Outdoor Education course for Grade 11s and 12s
- Students will learn about environmental stewardship and how to be responsible outdoors
- Students will participate in various activities such as:
- Water-based activities (paddle boarding, kayaking, swimming)
- Snow-based activities (snow shoeing, skiing etc.)
- Land-based activities (rock climbing, hiking, camping)
- NO EXPERIENCE NECESSARY! Just come with a positive attitude and a willingness to try new things
- Note: Students will be expected to travel in groups to locations outside of school and may be dismissed at 3 pm from these locations.

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

## CAREER LIFE CONNECTIONS 11/12

- CLC 11: workshops via collaborative time and related assignments
- 30 hours of work experience or community service
- CLC 12: A Capstone project that will help students set goals for post-secondary education or career pursuits, as well as reflect on their journey as a high school student
- A student-led interview in Grade 12


## ADVANCEMENT / AP

## BENEFITS OF AP

- AP can replace a Grade 12 ministry course for graduation
- AP class mark / grade can be used as an admission course for university applications in place of a ministry course
- Optional AP May Exam mark can be used for first year university course credit ( $4=86 \%, 5=96 \%$ )
- ie. AP Statistics = STAT 101(3) / SFU or STAT 200(3) / UBC
- ie. AP Biology = BISC 101(4) \& BISC 102(4) / SFU or BIOL $1^{\text {ST }}$ YEAR(8) / UBC
